

# DRAFT Letter of Agreement – PWC/CCS/SS

This agreement between the **City of Fayetteville’s Public Works Commission (PWC)**, the **Cumberland County School (CCS) District** and **Sustainable Sandhills (SS)** is intended to promote energy conservation and serve as a model for long term sustainability in North Carolina. Specifically, **PWC** agrees to invest \$20,000 with **SS** for projects related to energy conservation through the joint **SS/CCS Go Green Initiative** for those **CCS** facilities that are served, or will be served if new construction, by **PWC Electric Service**.

In consideration of **PWC’s** investment in energy conservation at its facilities, the **CCS** agrees to transfer to and allow **PWC** to hold and retire any and all Renewable Energy Certificates (REC) and Energy Efficiency Certificates (EEC) as defined by North Carolina legislation and/or the North Carolina Utility Commission (NCUC) under the Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency Portfolio Standard, derived from actions taken under the *Go Green Initiative* during the 2009-10 and 2010-11 academic years. The transfer, use and retiring of these REC/EEC will occur in compliance with the applicable regulations of the NCUC.

In consideration of **PWC’s** investment, **SS** will provide to **PWC** the required documentation to meet the NCUC’s measurement and verification requirements for REC/EEC. **PWC** shall provide **SS** all required back-up electric usage information, as required, in order to analyze savings and develop the required NCUC documents.

**SS** has three deliverables as part of this agreement. Monthly progress invoices may be submitted by **SS** to **PWC** for partial completion of each of the three deliverables.

1. Complete benchmarking of all **CCS** facilities with **PWC Electric Service** (\$10,000).
2. Provide education & training for **CCS** school occupants to spur energy conservation (\$8,000).
3. Complete REC/EEC documentation (\$2,000).
