Professor Whisnant is past President of the Conservation Trust of North Carolina, Inc. His publications include Rule Making in North Carolina (2005), Cleanup Law of North Carolina (2003), and Local Government for Environmental Policymakers (2002), as well as North Carolina's model Phase II and universal stormwater ordinances.

Professor Whisnant received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Philosophy with highest honors from UNC-Chapel Hill, and a Masters in Public Policy and J.D. *cum laude* from Harvard University.
